This is a friendly reminder from Animal Services regarding living among the wildlife we have here in the Village.

Animals will create dens under your deck so please enclose any open areas to prevent this. It is also helpful to use chimney caps, shore up foundations, and check for any roof openings and use steel wool/mesh before wildlife move in. LOCK your windows & doors & CARS to prevent bears entering at night and while you are gone. Wildlife deterrents can work when residents find property damage, but it is easier to stay ahead of the problem. PHOTOGRAPH instead of FEED wildlife. Feeding wildlife is a common and serious mistake that will cost the animal its life. Outdoor food sources must be bear proof or kept inside your locked home. We have a full compliment of wildlife protection laws.

The Feeding of Wildlife is an important one: “No person shall knowingly leave or store any refuse, food product, pet food, grain or salt in a manner which would constitute a lure, attraction or enticement of wildlife.” Fines increase from

\$75 to \$250 to a Court Summons.
