ORDINANCE SUMMARY

OFFICIAL NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 20, 2020, the Town Council approved as an emergency measure an ordinance titled as follows:

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL REVISING AND AMENDING THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF SNOWMASS VILLAGE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR COVID-19 PANDEMIC RELIEF EFFORTS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO BE DELIVERED TO THE PITKIN COUNTY COVID-19 RELIEF FUND FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, PEACE, SAFETY AND WELFARE

The proposed Ordinance provides for the Town's budget amendment to the 2020 Adopted Budget to fund the Pitkin County COVID-19 Relief Fund. The Ordinance has been adopted as an emergency measure and, in accordance with the Town Charter, has become effective upon passage.

FIRST READING OF THIS EMERGENCY ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED AT THE REGULAR MEETING ON APRIL 20th 2019 WITH A MOTION BY COUNCIL MEMBER GOODE, SECONDED BY COUNCIL MEMBER SIRKUS, AND UPON A VOTE OF 5 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
