TOWN OF SNOWMASS VILLAGE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION COORDINATED WITH PITKIN COUNTY NOVEMBER 3, 2020

The Town of Snowmass Village is accepting comments from the public regarding the Snowmass Village ASPEN SCHOOL DISTRICT ballot question which will appear on the November 3, 2020 Pitkin County ballot for Snowmass Village.

Colorado Election Law allows any voter to submit written comments about the financial ballot issues that will be decided in the November 3rd election. All comments will be summarized and mailed to all registered voters before the election. The comments may be either for or against the proposed ballot issues.

Comments must indicate whether their comment is in favor of or against the question. Only registered voters eligible to vote on the question can submit comments on the question, and comments must include a signature and the address where the signer is registered to vote. The deadline for submitting comments is Friday, September 18, 2020 at 4:30 p.m.

The question as it will appear on the ballot is as follows:

SHALL THE TOWN OF SNOWMASS VILLAGE'S EXISTING PROPERTY TAX FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES IN THE CURRENT ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$510,000.00, WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2021 FOR COLLECTION IN 2022, BE EXTENDED COMMENCING IN 2022 THROUGH 2026, THE FINAL COLLECTION YEAR TO BE 2027, BY THE IMPOSITION OF A MILL LEVY SUFFICIENT TO GENERATE \$510,000.00 ANNUALLY; SUCH TAXES TO BE USED FOR THE EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SUPPORT TO THE

ASPEN SCHOOL DISTRICT; TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF SNOWMASS VILLAGE FOR THE COSTS OF COLLECTION BY PITKIN COUNTY; THE REVENUES DERIVED FROM SUCH MILL LEVY SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE TOWN OF SNOWMASS VILLAGE AND BE DISBURSED THROUGH THE SNOWMASS VILLAGE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND TO ASPEN SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE TOWN AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSITITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW?
