AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-43 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE IN THE COMPENSATION PAID TO THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS

The Ordinance provides a reasonable and equitable increase in compensation in light of substantial commitment of time to fulfilling the duties of Council. The Ordinance will increase the compensation for Councilors and Mayor elected in 2024 by 10% over the current compensation and then 1.5% per year thereafter; and, for Councilors elected in 2024 by 13% over the current compensation and then 1.5% per year thereafter. Based on the Charter restrictions, the subsequent, automatic increases would only take effect upon each new term/election.

FIRST READING OF THIS ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED AT THE REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 2, 2023 WITH A MOTION BY COUNCILMEMBER FRIDSTEIN, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER MAROLT, AND UPON A VOTE OF 5 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.

SECOND READING OF THIS ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED AT THE REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 2, 2023 WITH A MOTION BY COUNCILMEMBER SKENK, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER MAROLT, AND UPON A ROLL CALL VOTE OF 5 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
