TID BITS:

- Check out the new Village Shuttle App, it's up and working well. The feedback from the ridership has been very positive.
- In July we will be bringing the renewal for the Black Hills Natural Gas franchise agreement to the Council to consider. A franchise agreement is essentially a (fancy) 20+ year lease agreement for utilities to use town owned right-of-way to deliver their service.
- We are working to finalize an RFP to hire a construction manager/ general contractor for the Draw site. Hiring a contractor at this stage helps with pricing and very critical design development.
- The demolition of and replacement of the Snowmass Inn roof starts next week.
- The Lower Kearns Road culvert project will be completed (the road will be fully opened) by early July.
- The new bridge over Videl Gulch will be receiving a little love and maintenance in the coming weeks. Because the bridge was installed in the winter months, more compaction around the abutments is needed. This will require that we shut the bridge for a couple of days.
- We are starting Phase 2 of the fiber optic cable installation in July.
- The project to stabilize the Woodbridge starts next week. Because we are replacing the decking, a shutdown of the bridge will be required for a period of time in July.
- Highline Road is on track to be completed next week.
- We-cylce bikes will be e-bikes next year. Planning for these newfangled bikes is underway.
- Events are in full swing. The Rock Garden Stage opened last Saturday and the first Fanny Hill concert was yesterday. Discovery Days is next weekend and the rodeo kicks off on June 19.
- Speaking of the rodeo, all 350 community tickets have been given out for the June 26 rodeo. They were given away on a first come, first served basis. We held back 150 tickets to give to Boards and Commission members.
- All the cool kids are following Snowmass local on Instagram. This new channel is designed to help our local shops and restaurants better get their word out about what is going in their businesses.

- Construction continues in Base Village.
- Town Park is getting soooooo close to completion.
- Life is Good.
