WINTER WINDOWS

This winter, we are launching a project called Snowmass Winter Windows. We are pairing ten RFV artists with ten retailers on the Snowmass Mall to create custom window displays that celebrate the winter season and the character of Snowmass Village. Winter Windows launches during Wintersköl, December 12-15, with judging and community voting on December 14 during the Winter Intentions Lantern Display and an awards ceremony on December 15 during the Snowmass Retro Party.

TID BITS

- December occupancy is projecting to be down by double digits this year from last year. We'll have to see if this snow helps increase this number.
- October was another record month for Aspen Airport by a wide margin due to Delta continuing year-round service from both ATL & LAX combined with significant capacity increases from United. Scheduled flights were up 53%. Total arriving and departing passengers were up 35%.
- The construction crews from Timberline Condos are expected to have all of their construction materials and equipment removed from Lot 12 by December 10.

- The pedestrian Woodbridge is open. There is still work to complete and more inspections to occur, but we expect to keep the bridge open the rest of the season.
- The Brush Creek trail is open for pedestrian activity. It's not paved, but it will be groomed.
- Rental renewal notices went out today to all of our renters. Each renter will be requalified (ensuring work requirements are met) as their leases renew.
- The Parking Office is in full "GO" mode with people and businesses scrambling to get their permits.
- The Recreation Center is cranking with Kids Camp, free cross country ski rentals, the Black Friday membership pass sale, and everyone else trying to get their waistband ready for Thanksgiving.
- We plan to get the Employee Survey underway soon.
